Iconic Men's League Rules

Uniform	Free Agents: Iron Courts Iconic Reversible Jersey Teams: Reversible Jersey or Same Color T-Shirt
Rim Height	10 feet
Game Length	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 18 min halves running clock • The clock stops during the last two minutes of each half • The game will be called if the point differential is 20 points or more in the last two minutes of regulation • 30 second shot clock
Timeouts	Three (3) :30 second timeouts for the entirety of regulation.
Fouls	6 personal fouls. If a player is fouled on a missed 2 point shot, they will be awarded 1 point and given 1 free throw attempt. If a player is fouled on a missed 3 point shot, they will be awarded 1 point and given 2 free throws attempts. Fouls on made shots are awarded 1 point. Bonus at 10 team fouls per half, 1 free throw for 2 points. Traditional double bonus during the final 2 minutes of regulation
Defense	Any defense or press allowed.
Technical Fouls	Automatic 2 pts plus ball.
Ejections / Suspensions / Fighting	<p>Any ejections will result in removal of the facility and 1 game suspension. Second ejection will result in a 2 game suspension. 3 ejections will result in removal of the league.</p> <p>Any players initiating a fight with another player, making unwanted and unwarranted contact with an official, or threatening a player or official will be suspended from the league indefinitely.</p>
Coaches	2 coaches per team are allowed on the bench. Only 1 coach can stand on the sidelines and address the referees.
Roster	Teams must have a minimum of 5 players. Teams are allowed a roster up to 12 players. A player must participate in at least 4 league games to be eligible for the Playoffs.
Overtime	<p>1st overtime: 2 minutes. 2nd overtime: Sudden victory - First point/score wins.</p> <p>1 timeout per team in 1st overtime. No timeouts for 2nd overtime. Timeouts do not carry over from regulation. Traditional 2-shot free throws</p>
Reminders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The goal is for every team to compete, get better, grow the game of basketball, and learn the valuable skills of character and sportsmanship. • Players, coaches, parents, and spectators not demonstrating sportsmanship will be removed from the game and/or league. • Coaches, players, and spectators are not permitted to yell or berate officials at any time. The expectation is to cheer for their team.
